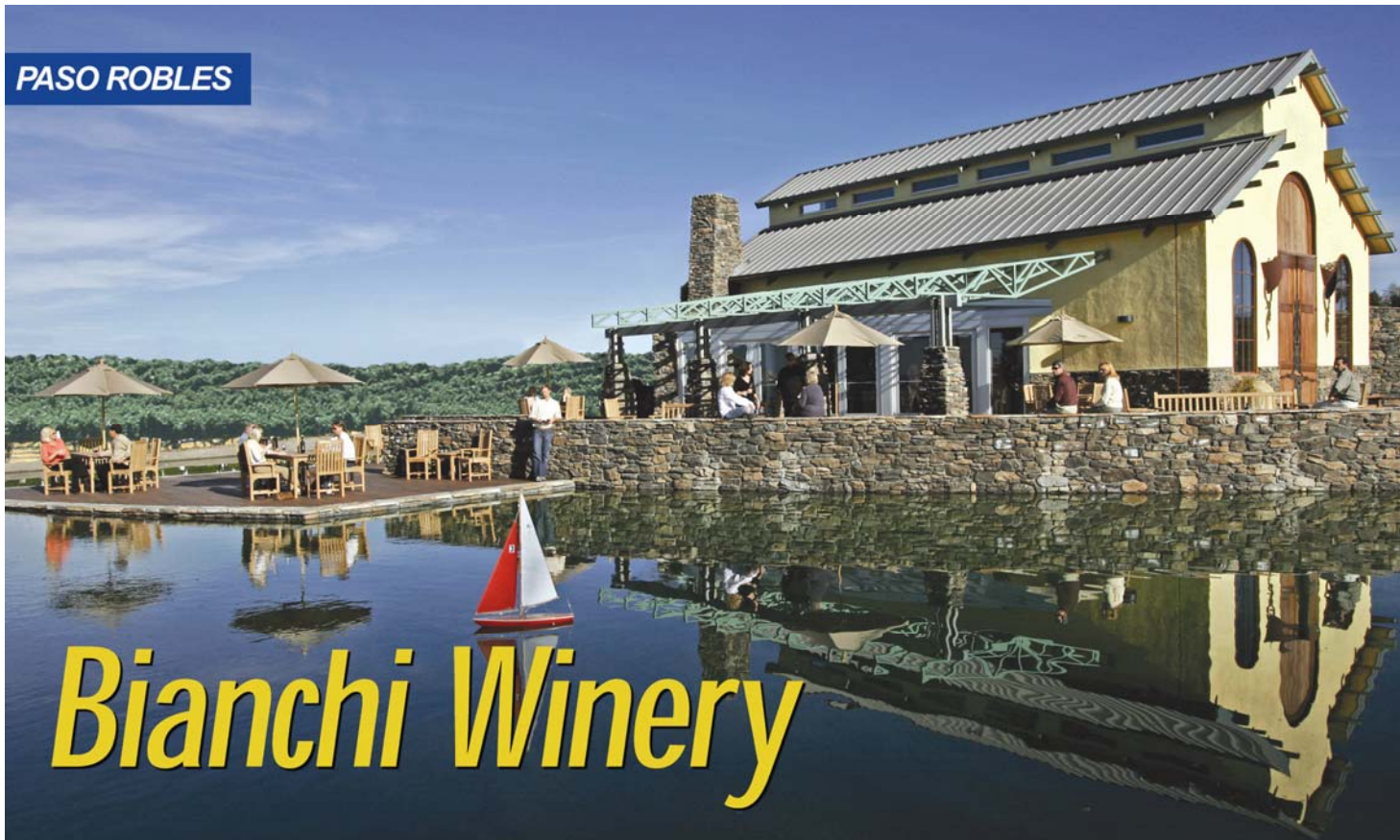
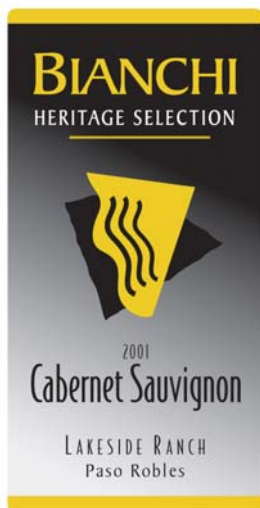

The exceptional wines of Bianchi are the product of great estate and select vineyards, artisan winemaking and the Bianchi family's dedication to producing ultra-premium wines. When Glenn Bianchi created a vision for building a winery to produce the family's wines, he was challenged with finding the perfect location. Glenn chose Paso Robles, admiring the regions reputation for outstanding vineyards and outstanding wines, as well as its natural beauty. In May of 2004, Glenn completed construction of a modern wine facility and a stunning tasting room complimented by a lake on 40 acres of prime vineyard located seven miles east of Paso Robles.

For Bianchi visitors, the sweeping vineyard and mountain views, inviting tast-

ing room and serene lake couple with inspired wines offer a fulfilling wine country experience. The welcoming tasting room is an architectural feast for the senses with rustic stonework, modern beams and floor to ceiling windows that frame beautiful vineyard and lake views. A fireplace warms the tasting room in the winter and cool breezes off the lake refresh the room in the summer. "Whether enjoying our wines inside or outside, guests enjoy our relaxed, un-hurried nature," states owner Glenn Bianchi. "It's how wine tasting should be."

Intense tropical aromas enhanced with pineapple, kiwi, and mango. \$14

'04 Pinot Grigio, Arroyo Grande

Floral aromas with honeysuckle, melon, and a crisp, clean finish. \$18

'01 Merlot, Paso Robles

Intense aromas of Bing cherry and plum with berry and malt flavors. \$18

'02 Cabernet Sauvignon, Lakeside Ranch, Paso Robles

Aromas of cherry, cassis, and cedar with berry and plum flavors. \$22
