### Winemakers Notes

Big Barbera burgeoning with rich aromas of vanilla wood spice...Mouth-filling meaty round flavors of plum jam and cherry that tactilely do the tango on your tongue...This is an interesting wine from the shy-producing very ripe harvest of '06. It evolves on ones palate with layers of flavors. Our Barbera fermented in small open-top bins where we punched down the grape skin cap by hand. This gentle treatment and small mass fermented at relatively cool temperatures yielding a wine of fine up-front tannin structure, rather pleasant. I could enjoy Bianchi Barbera with lightly blackened Salmon or a juicy flank steak.
