Winemakers Notes

Syranot (pronounced *seer-an-oh*) is Bianchi's sumptuous and complex mélange of powerful Paso Robles Syrah (77%) with silky cool-mesoclimate Pinot Noir (23%). *Syranot* flavors run rampant with Syrah's deep cherrywood and hints of tar, while moderated by Pinot Noir's cinnamon-berry and the vanilla of French oak. Age-able tannins exist, and with the taming of Pinot's chalky structure, we have a wine for now and for your aging cellar. Please help us enjoy *Syranot* with a sumptuous Petit Fillet of Angus atop the complex sauce *Marchand de Vin* (the *Vin* being *Syranot*, of course).
